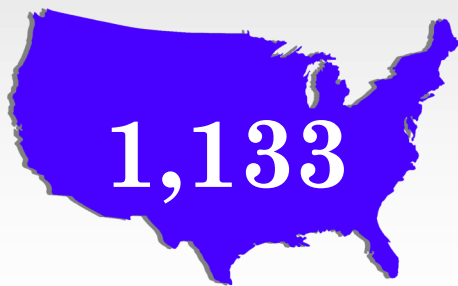


Combating Zika

Transmission

- Through the bite of an infected *Aedes* species mosquito.
- Through intercourse with an infected man.
- From pregnant mother to child.



Reported Zika Cases



COMMON SYMPTOMS: Fever, Rash, Joint Pain, and Conjunctivitis

SERIOUS ZIKA RISK: Birth Defects (Microcephaly) to Unborn Babies

Preventing Zika in Virginia



Use EPA-registered insect repellent spray



Wear protective clothing to ward off mosquitoes



Tip standing water containers, toss debris where it collects



Use prophylactics during intercourse



Seek immediate medical attention if you exhibit Zika symptoms
